## MINUTE 444.14 PROPOSAL ON REVISED PROCEDURES FOR ENDORSEMENT OF GRADUATION STATUS, CENTRE FOR POSTGRADUATE STUDIES - S.P. NO. D1542/444/2018

## 1.0 The Senate was presented with the following:

A proposal on revised procedures to enhance the current graduation status endorsement process by delegating the power to endorse the graduation status to the Center for Postgraduate Studies (CPS).

- 1.1 By delegating the power to endorse the graduation status to CPS, the completion of study letters, official academic transcripts and scrolls can be processed more effectively and released to students earlier.
- 1.2 The proposed revised procedures are as follows:
  - a. CPS will prepare a list for endorsement after receiving a recommendation and complete submission for graduation, e.g. hardbound thesis, i.e., duly completed thesis binding along with other related documents from the Centres of Studies;
  - b. A meeting on endorsement of graduation status will be conducted to endorse the graduate status together with, if any, the updated thesis title and supervisory committee members.
  - c. CPS will update graduation status within one (1) week after the endorsement.
  - d. Similar to current procedure, the completion of studies letters, official academic transcripts and scrolls can only be collected once the students have completed their university clearance process;
  - e. The Senate will be notified of all the endorsements.

Details of the proposal are as appended in the 444<sup>th</sup> Senate e-Meeting system.

## 2.0 Senate decision

2.1 The Senate **endorsed** the revised procedures to enhance the current graduation status endorsement process by CPS as presented.

PROPOSAL FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF INTERNATIONAL ADMISSION COMMITTEE, INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADMISSIONS S.P. NO. D1543/444/2018

1.0 The Senate was presented with the following:

A proposal for the establishment of an International Admission Committee for International Student Admissions. This matter was discussed in the Students Admission Committee meeting No.1/2018 held on 27<sup>th</sup> February 2018 and is now being brought for approval by Senate.

- 1.1 International Student Admission (INSAN) is handling the admission process for international undergraduate and postgraduate students. Effective from 1 September 2017, INSAN is under the purview of the International Office.
- 1.2 INSAN has conducted meetings on international applications with the Deputy Rector of Internationalization & Industry and Community Relations and selected members.
- 1.3 The establishment of the International Admission Committee will allow immediate offering of any international applications into IIUM undergraduate and postgraduate programmes.
- 1.4 It will also enhance the international student admission related processes such as offer, appeal and deferment.
